Literacy

Spelling

We are learning to spell words with our new spelling patterns.

Writing

We are learning to write an imaginative story.

You will be creating an imaginative story by using a story starter. This will help you imagine your setting and to continue the story in the same style. Think about who's there, what things can you see, where are you in the story and how are you feeling at that time.

Reading

We are learning to create true and false statements.

Choose a story, non-fiction book or magazine. AFTER reading or listening complete this activity.

Lie detector – write 10 true or false statements about your book. Share with a family member who has read the book, can they guess which are true or false?

Numeracy

Maths Topic – Fractions

We are learning to identify fractions of an amount.

Hot – Calculate $\frac{1}{2}$ and $\frac{1}{4}$ of an amount

Bonus task – can you show fractions with your food? Cut up your food into parts, take a photo and send to your teacher telling them what fraction it represents. For example, I cut my toast into four parts, I take away one part which leaves me with three quarters of toast!
