## Literacy

### Spelling

In 2, write about things that happened and in the 3<sup>rd</sup> paragraph describe your thoughts and feelings, explaining why it was such a great holiday.

## Numeracy

### 24 Game:

You know the drill – make 24 using all 4 numbers. Can you beat your parents?

### Data Handling

Make a tally chart of the colour of socks that you have or a tally chart of the colours of cars that go past your home.

### Data Handling

Complete the tally mark counting sheets attached. This work will also be posted on Teams.

### Problem Solving – investigation.

Using the numbers 1 to 6 how many different totals can you make up? You can use any amount of the numbers, but you cannot use the same number twice in the same sum.

E.g.  $1 + 4 \times 3 = \text{OK}$      $1 + 2 + 1 = \text{Not OK}$ .
