Literacy

Writing:

Use one of the story ideas, or use your own, to write an ocean themed story:

- You are going out with your friends on a deep sea treasure hunting adventure.
- You come face to face with a terrifying new sea creature.
- While scuba diving you discover a cave under the ocean surface and you decide to explore.
- You have fallen into the ocean and transformed into a mermaid.

Converting measures of length.

There are lots of units we use to measure how long something is. Watch the teaching video and have a go at working on metres, centimetres and millimetres.

Comparing mass and capacity.

Mass is how much of something there is (we sometimes think of it as its weight) and capacity is how much something can contain inside it. Watch the teaching video and then have a go comparing objects and using the different units we have for measuring mass and capacity.
